TAKE NOTICE that the Village of Clayton Board of Trustees is accepting sealed bids for the purchase of #2 Fuel Oil and LP Gas to be delivered to the following locations:

**#2 Fuel Oil – Two (2) Locations:**

Village Municipal Building, Mary St., Clayton, NY  
*Approximately 5,500 gallons per year*

Low Lift Water Plant, Bartlett Point, Clayton, NY  
*Approximately 1,600 gallons per year*

**LP Gas – Three (3) Locations:**

Water Treatment Plant, Bartlett Point Rd., Clayton, NY  
*Approximately 3,500 gallons per year*

Hawn Memorial Library, John St., Clayton, NY  
*Approximately 2,800 gallons per year*

Bathhouse, Mary Street dock, Clayton, NY  
*Approximately 100 gallons (seasonal)*

and any other sites as needed, for a time period commencing 8/1/2008 through 7/31/2009. Prices should be based on the base prices posted at the close of business on July 21, 2008. In addition, burner service rates should be listed in the bid.

Sealed bids will be received at the Village Clerk's Office, 425 Mary Street, PO Box 250, Clayton, NY until 3:00 PM on Monday, July 28, 2008 and will be publicly opened and read at the Village Board Meeting that same date at 6:30 PM at the Municipal Building, 425 Mary Street, Clayton, NY. Bids are to be submitted in a sealed envelope marked "Fuel Bid."

No bids will be considered without the completion of the Non-Collusive Statement, as required by General Municipal Law, 103-d, which includes the signature of the bidder or his/her representative.

All vendor supplied LP gas tanks are to be in a well-painted condition and properly tested. If the bid is awarded to a vendor other than the present supplier, the owner/vendor of the LP gas tank(s) will pump out and issue credit for contents where necessary.

The Village Board reserves the right to reject any or all bids as the best interests of the Village may require.
