Sealed bids for the construction of the Riverside Drive Pumping Station Rehabilitation, Contract No.1, will be received at the office of the Village Clerk, Village of Clayton, 425 Mary Street, Clayton, New York 13624, until 11:00 A.M., Local Time, June 4, 2010 and there at said office at said time publicly opened and read aloud.

This project includes new piping and electrical components for Riverside Drive Pumping Station Rehabilitation, Village of Clayton, Jefferson County, New York.

The Contract Documents may be obtained only from the office of O'Brien & Gere, 5000 Brittonfield Parkway, East Syracuse, New York, 13057, upon deposit of the sum of \$50 per set. **Checks shall be made payable to the Village of Clayton.** The full amount of deposit for one set of Contract Documents will be refunded to any Bidder who has duly submitted a bid accompanied by the bid security required by this Advertisement and who returns the Contract Documents complete and in good condition within thirty days following the award of the Contract or the rejection of the bid. The full amount of deposit for one set of Contract Documents will be refunded to the successful Bidder upon the execution of the Contract Documents. A partial refund in the amount of \$25 will be made for the return, within thirty days following the award of the Contract or the rejection of the bids, of other sets of Contract Documents complete and in good condition.

Copies of the above described Contract Documents may be examined at no expense at the Office of the Village Clerk, Village of Clayton, 425 Mary Street, Clayton, New York 13624 and the office of O'Brien & Gere, 5000 Brittonfield Parkway, East Syracuse, New York, 13057.

The Owner is exempt from the payment of sales and compensating use taxes of the State of New York and of cities and counties on all materials, equipment and supplies sold to the Owner pursuant to this Contract. Also exempt from such taxes are purchases by the Contractor and his Subcontractors of materials, equipment and supplies to be sold to the Owner pursuant to this Contract, including tangible personal property to be incorporated in any structure, building or other real property forming part of the Project. These taxes are not to be included in the Bid.


Each Bid must be accompanied by cash, certified check, cashier's check or bid bond in an amount not less than five percent (5%) of the amount of the Bid in the form and subject to the conditions provided in the Information for Bidders.

The work under this Contract is to be aided by funds pursuant to the Community Capital Assistance Program ("CCAP") administered by the Dormitory Authority of the State of New York. The Contractor shall follow the non-discrimination and affirmative policies of the State of New York and the Authority and document his efforts to not discriminate and promote affirmative action on this project.
